The public hearing is being held pursuant to Section 15.2-2506 of the Code of Virginia, 1950 as amended, allowing the public to question and comment on the proposed budget. This proposed budget reflects a \$0.08 increase in the current real estate tax rate.

In accordance with Section 15.2-2506, Code of Virginia, notice is hereby given that the White Stone Town Council will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 6th, 2024 as a part of the regular Council meeting, beginning at 6:00 p.m., on the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2025. At this hearing, all interested citizens will be given an opportunity to express their views. The proposed FY-2025 budget anticipates the expenditure of \$3,830 more in General Funds compared to the amended FY-2024 budget.
